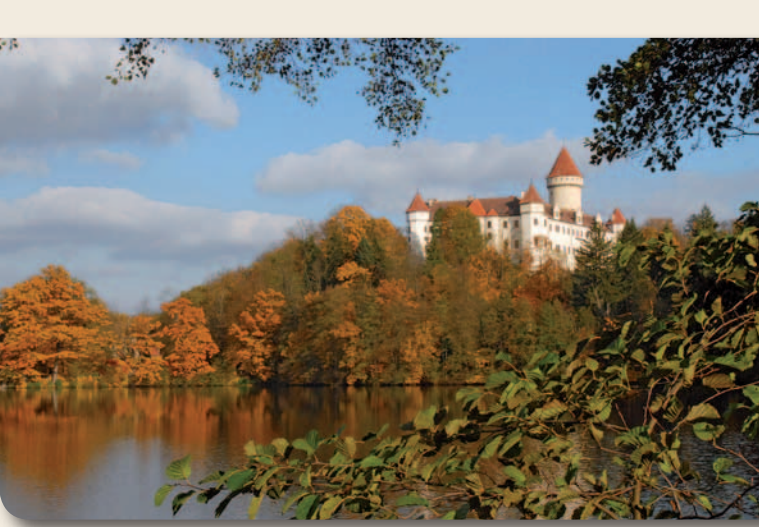

Welcome to the region named after one of the most beautiful Czech rivers - the Sázava.

The region full of natural beauties historical places of interest and mysterious legends. You may follow their tracks and enjoy extraordinary experiences, adventures and great entertainment. Sit down into a boat and set off to the ferocious rapids. Or take one of many hiking paths or cycling routes winding through the country of forests, meadows and pastures. You can also meet the new experiences on a horse back, in a balloon or on the legendary Posázavský Pacifik train. Or would you prefer sightseeing or dining with your friends? Are you a friend of sports activities, even if they are the adrenaline ones? Then do not hesitate and come to visit the region of Posázaví as soon as possible!





When meandering around the Posázaví, don't miss out on a visit to Český Šternberk castle, you will be rewarded with a view of the gothic castle which majestically shoots up to a point over the river Sázava. During the tour around the grounds, you will be able to take a glimpse into the more than seventy year history connected largely to the Sternberg lineage. The castle was founded around 1241 by Zdeslav of Sternberg.

The tour route leads through fifteen rooms rich with stylish furniture and enhanced with a collection of family portraits, porcelain, weapons, hunting trophies as well as silver miniatures. Among the most interesting exhibits, undoubtedly includes a collection of graphic papers dating back to the period of the Thirty Years War.

Would you like to take a peek into the authentic surroundings of the homes of gentry folk from the first house of the last century? If so, then Český Šternberk castle is the right choice for you. Until now it has been inhabited by descendants of the former founder, Zdeslav of Sternberg. If you make it for the last weekend in May along with the children, there will be special tours for them complete with a guide dressed in period costume. And should you wish to learn more, don't miss taking a pilgrimage around Šternberk's history during the penultimate weekend in October – including tours enhanced with play scenes taken from the history of the castle and the life of its residents.

Český Šternberk castle



South of the castle, you will stumble across an outpost bastion, the so-called dungeon. It is part of an ingenious rampart system installed at the turn of the 15th and 16th centuries. From May till the end of August 2012, an exhibition on old-style prams is running at the castle. Aside from historical prams for children from 1860 to 1960, you will also be able to see dolls, period clothing for babies, swaddling clothes, pillows, exhibits of children's bedrooms and pots and pans for dolls.

One-day trips along the Sázava:
Camping site „Pod mostem“ in Kácov – Český Šternberk (13 km)
Český Šternberk – Sázava (21 km)
Trips through one of the most scenic parts of the Sázava region suitable even for the beginners. The trips may be combined with the visit of Český Šternberk castle or the brewery in Kácov.
Týnec nad Sázavou – Píkovice (16 km)
The river winds in between rocks and forms nice rapids. There are also several navigable weirs in this section of the river. We nevertheless do not recommend this river part to novice paddlers.

Konopiště castle



The original impregnable gothic fortress Konopiště was founded 700 years ago. In conjunction with a change in proprietor's, so too changed the look of Konopiště castle. In 1887 it was purchased by the archduke, František Ferdinand d'Este, subsequently heir to the Austro-Hungarian throne. After marrying the Czech countess, Žofie Chotkova, the castle became the home of the archduke family.

Once within the rich interior of the castle, you can admire rare collections dominating the space, the so-called Estensky armoury station which ranks among the largest in Europe. The large trophy hall is testimony to František Ferdinand's passion for hunting who, during his life time, managed to kill almost 300.000 animals. A glimpse into the private apartments of the successor's family also offers a unique opportunity.

The other monuments of interest include the house of the former District Health Insurance Company, Ferdinand brewery or Sokol gymnasium. In the town centre there is a Church of St. Anna with the Piarist College, the Museum of Arts and Design and a Museum of Blaník region. In this place the town continues with its historical part called Karlov with the St. Nicholas Church, belfries, ruin of the Minorite monastery and a Jewish cemetery. To see these places you can also travel by the municipal tourist eco-train.

Benešov Brewery

The brewery of Benešov was established by the Archduke Ferdinand d'Este in 1897. For the whole time of its existence the brewery has been using traditional technology of sedimentary fermentation in open fermentation rooms and maturation in lager cellars. The beer production is based on the original formula of brewing, using solely the Czech malt and the best hops cultivated in Žatec region. Ferdinand beer is distinctive thanks to its gold-like colour, sparkling brilliance, strong tang, full taste and high foam.



The brewery production includes seven brands of beer, from the non-alcoholic to the special ones, being sold both on the domestic and foreign markets. The production range is complemented with the raspberry and orange lemonades Ferdinandáda.

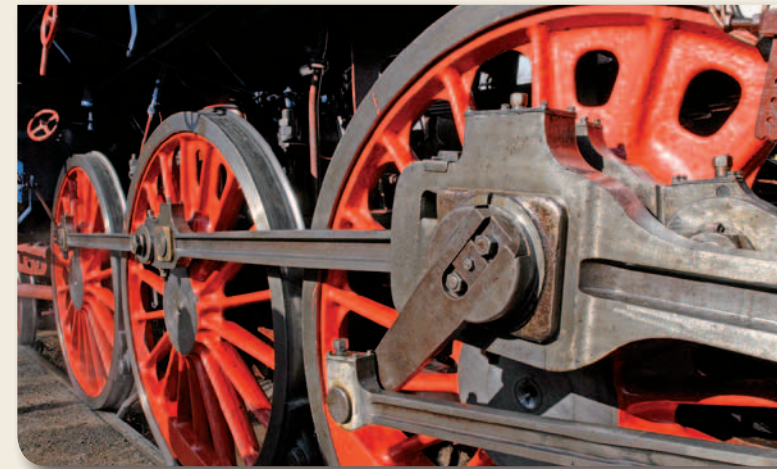

This legendary railway line from Prague to Světlá nad Sázavou has been running now for more than 100 years and continues to rank among the most sought after transport arteries. It takes you through beautiful countryside along the Sázava river. It acquired this popular name due to young campers who set off on it in search of adventure in the style of the Wild West which they had read about in the books of Jack London and E.T. Seton.

You can travel along this romantic route on several of the regular personal trains as well as a significant number of excursion carriers pulled, above all, by historical steam or motor locomotives.

Come and take a trip along the romantic railway in the valley of the Sázava on a regular passenger train, a historical train or on your own and private train booked in advance. Enjoy local beautiful nature and skills of our ancestors. The Posázavský Pacific train will for instance take you to the golden mines in Jílové u Prahy, to the Military Technical Museum Lešany, the ruins of Zlenice castle, Sázava monastery, Český Šternberk castle, Kácov brewery, Zruč nad Sázavou castle or Stvořidla river rapids.



Royal town of Jílové u Prahy

The town of Jílové u Prahy and its surroundings represent one of the most beautiful places in vicinity of Prague. It was founded in the 13th century as a miner's settlement and its rich history is closely connected with gold mining. In the town historical centre there are three significant historical monuments from the pre-Hussite era, one of them being the Church of St. Adalbert with a unique Gothic tabular altar. The town square is dominated by the Town Hall with well preserved „municipal prison“ in the original tower fortress. Another significant historical monument is the House Mince (the Coin) which used to be a seat of the gold mining management a the place of tax payment. In present, the building houses Regional Museum with permanent expositions mapping gold mining and history of the region, complemented with exhibitions on various topics.



Other tourist places of interest include the Church of Corpus Christi built in the 14th century located at the local cemetery. The allegedly healing water springs in the town part called Lázně (Spa) near the Chapel of St. Wenceslas.

The scenic landscape of the Sázava valley surrounded by massive uplands also invites to trips. It is interwoven with numerous tourist paths. The visitors may for instance go to the bridge of Žampach, which is one of the highest stone railway bridges and a technical unique. Another trip destination may be the lookout tower of Pepř hill offering startling views of the surrounding landscape.

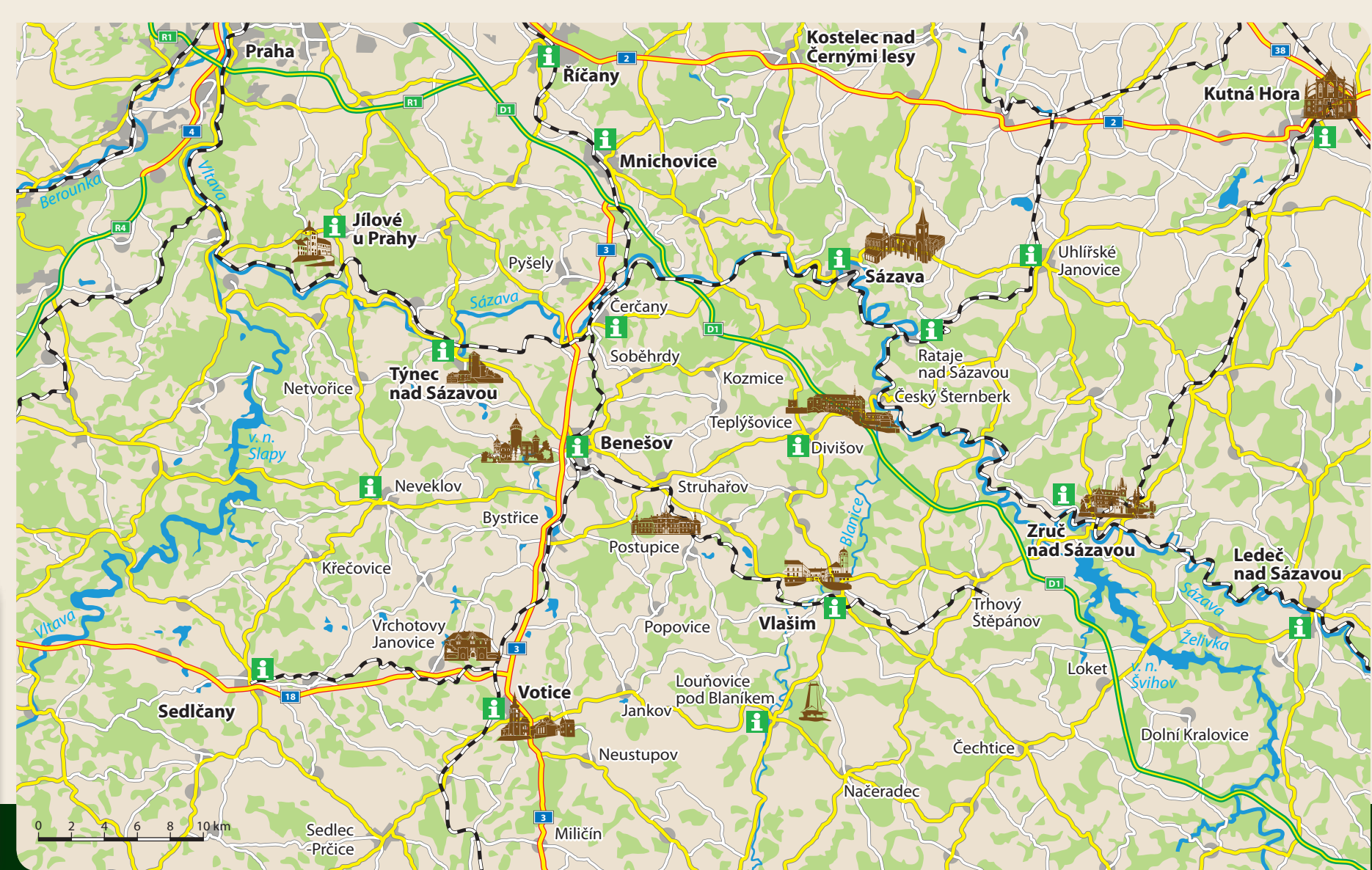
Another place worth visiting is the the drift of St. Joseph in Dolní Studené, which is one of many mine works of the Jílové gold-bearing area. Some 100 metres from there there is another mining site - the drift of St. Anthony of Padua where the last mining work was carried out in the first half of the 18th century. The drift Halře reminds of the youngest stage of the gold mining in the Jílové area since it was established in the mid 20th century.

The region is nevertheless alive also in winter thanks to the Ski resort Chotouň situated nearby the town in the village of Pohoří and offering unique possibility of quality skiing experience.

Břejlov Mill

The mill Břejlov is located in the charming surroundings of the Sázava river in a distance of 30 kilometres from Prague and only 300 metres from the international Greenways cycling path. It is the perfect place to relax, as a venue for your wedding or another celebration for sport recreation but also all kinds of training, teambuilding and outdoor activities.

The third floor of the hotel has three fully furnished training rooms. On the second and third floors there are 55 beds with two-bedroom to four-bedroom rooms with their own bathroom facilities. The garden has seven huts, each of which has its own bathroom and five beds. There is also an onsite car park, volley and feet volleyball pitch, large fireplace, place for your bike and a jetty to leave your boats.

Lešany military technical museum



Each year during the opening and course of the summer season, events are held on the grounds of the Lešany museum including presentations of military technology in movement: May – launch of the season, August – Tank day.

The area can be found between the communities of Krhanice and Lešany u Týnce nad Sázavou and forms part of the Prague Military Institute. The museum is located on the premises of a former artillery barracks. The exhibitions currently constitute more than 700 historical tanks, canons, motorcycles, armoured, loading and personal vehicles, rocket technology and engineering resources as well as logistical material emerging from 1890 till the modern day.

The museum's technology stretches across ten halls, under six sheds as well as in open spaces. In terms of scale and composition, the collections are unique, ranking among the most significant European institutes of their kind.

Among the most sought after tourist destinations include the stone Roman rotunda from the 11th century or the watch tower in the prismatic Gothic tower from the 13th century which is the summer residence of the protected large mouse-eared bat. Inside Týnec castle you will find a museum with a rare exposition of the Týnec stoneware.

The jewel of this town is the circular First Republic villa belonging to the industrialist, Ing. František Janeček, one of the founders of the former JAWA motorcycle manufacturing plant. The 14th century ruined castle Zbořený Kostelec is also worth a look. Once upon a time it had been protected as a trading path across the Sázava river, the establishment of which also involved the Czech King, Václav II.

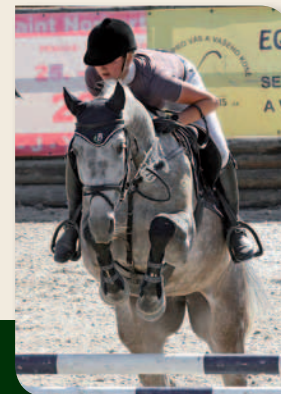

Sázava town

Sázava is above all linked to the life of the Czech patron Saint Prokop. Until recently people believed that its history didn't begin until the Middle Ages however archaeological finds have discovered that there was human presence on the territory of the town already during the period of the Agricultural Age.



Set out to the new five km walking path through the bio-corridor area along the Sázava river from Budínský weir past the Natural Park Havránka to Krkavčí skály (the Raven Rocks). Enjoy beautiful views of interesting places related to a thousand years old history of the town of Sázava.



Among prominent personalities of the Sázava included František Kavalír, founder of the former glassworks. The restorer of the Slavic Sázava, Peter Method Klement, a Sázava pastor also worked here. The playwright, poet and actor, Jiří Voskovec was born here later also spending time here. In his honour the local theatre group has organised a competition show of amateur dramas called Voskovec's Sázava.



Sázava cloister

This was founded in 1032. The exposition entitled „Saint Prokop's Sázava“ tells the life story of the Czech national patron saint Prokop and the thousand year long history of his cloister. In the north garden of the cloister you can find exposed foundations of the church of the Holy Cross from the 11th century, once inside the convent you will see a rare capitular hall dating back to the 14th century. In 2007 a rich Baroque and Gothic fresco adornment piece was discovered in the hallway of the cloister.

Legendary Blaník Mountain



The forested couplet of Velký and Malý Blaník is located right in the heart of Posázaví area and is the smallest protected landscape area of the Czech Republic. According to the legend an army sleeps deep in the mountain interior led by Saint Wenceslas, the patron of the Czech lands, that will ride out to help the Czech nation when the times get the worst. The Blaník area, presenting itself as a region of Blaník knights, is abound in natural beauties and rich history.

At the foot of Velký Blaník begins the instructional nature trail „With a Knight to Blaník“. It is 4 km long and there are 14 educational stops and 17 playful stops for children. The visitors can see here a copy of the National Theatre foundation stone acquired on Blaník mountain or a statue of a knight. The instructional trail includes geological exposition of local minerals and rocks. On the top of the hill there is a lookout tower offering view into the surrounding countryside.

In the nearby Louňovice pod Blaníkem, the birth place of the music composer Jan Dismas Zelenka (1679–1745), there is a new Museum of Beekeeping of the Podblanicko region.



Vlašim town

In 2010 reconstruction work on the historical centre was completed. Its history dates back to 1318 when the castle over the Blanice river is mentioned. In the first over of the 16th century, the St Jiljí church was founded. The deanship building and the Old Town Hall bear reference to Baroque style while the former loan office and school building are reminiscent of the 19th Century. Among modern day first republic features include the husite church. In its current form, the square, river banks along with bridge make Vlašim an attractive town for tourists.



In the last third of the 18th century, the Auersperg family founded this natural landscape park by the castle. It was built on the spot of the former enclosure and was occupied with many constructions, sculptures and coves. The part, just like the castle is publically open. In 2008 the Chinese pavilion was made accessible. The old castle and baths have also been reconstructed. Refreshments are also on offer at the park gates dating back to the 19th century.

Museum of Podblanicko region

As of 1988, Vlašim castle which has been based inside the museum of Podblanicko region and has another operations running in Benešov and Růžkove Lhotice. A visit to the castle offers the opportunity to view the exposition called castle parks and the history of Vlašim castle. With an exact blade – the tradition of hunting and armoury and the longstanding exhibition of a Mirror to the past.

The whole experience from the visit is amplified by the castle interiors, the chapel, fresco stucco decorated halls and also the large amount of antique, natural and technical exhibits on display. You can walk around Vlašim castle from the vault to the tower. The view invites you to view other parts of the town including žižkov square with a fountain knight Roland. From 1936 Vlašim has been home to the world-famous ammunition works, Sellier & Bellot. The table of its co-founder P.D. Sellier can also be seen again and again at the exposition of the Podblanicka museum. A new feature is the enhanced set of exotic trophies which brings together the collection of five aristocratic family lines.

Kondrac

The Kondrac village is 5 km southwards of Vlašim. The settlements of Dub and Krasovice which lie on the foothills of the renowned Blaník hill, also known for its various legends. The first mention of Kondrac dates back to 1318 but the current church of St. Bartholomew is already from the 12th century. The surroundings of Kondrac are an ideal place for relaxing and taking a holiday as it's interwoven with cycle routes and tourist as well as educational routes.



During sufficient snow fall a ski lift is also in operation. Visitors may use the services of both hostels. The restaurant here U Matoušků is renowned throughout the region.

Kondrac lives a rich club life. It was also awarded for this – in 2007 it became the village of the year for the Central Bohemia region and in a nationwide competition round it was awarded second place.



The Parish Museum

In 2010 the Parish Museum was opened in Kondrac which is the first of its kind in the Czech Republic. With its farming tradition, chanel house and Roman church of St. Bartholomew, it offers the authentic interior of a parish from the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries. There is a craft workshop in the main building with the option of producing candles, hand-made paper or painting prints in the period theme of saints.

By the parish there is a herb garden with plants of symbolic religious meaning. It not only includes an area to relax but also a sheep range which undoubtedly previously belonged to the parish farm.

Would you like to take a look at the erstwhile dwelling of a village pastor? Come over for a visit! You will see an ordinary household with an enormous stove, wooden cupboards, tile stones and an old-fashioned bed. You can smell the bee honey here as well as the laughter of children. You see the parish museum is a living one!
